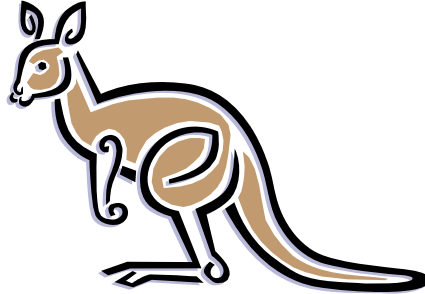

Meetings are held at local meeting places. Please contact the chapter for more information about meeting locations.

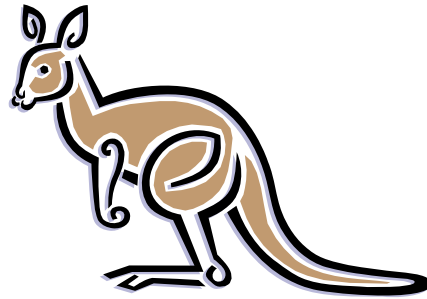
Our meetings provide help and support for the ostomate and families...we provide tips and information for living with an ostomy, and we offer emotional and technical support... and we have fun in the process.
